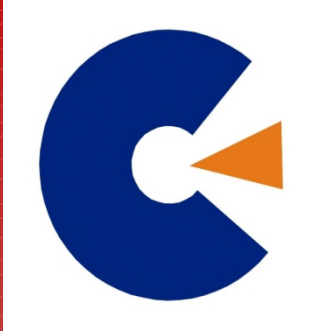

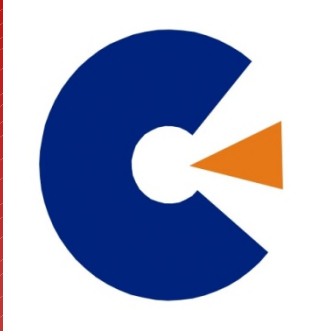

What is Risk Assessment?



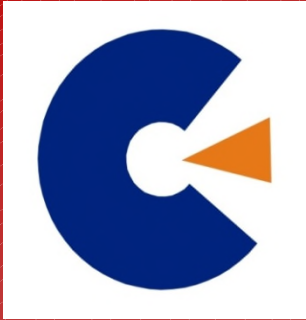
Dynamic / Generic / Specific
