Organised by Grant Aided Heating Installers Network

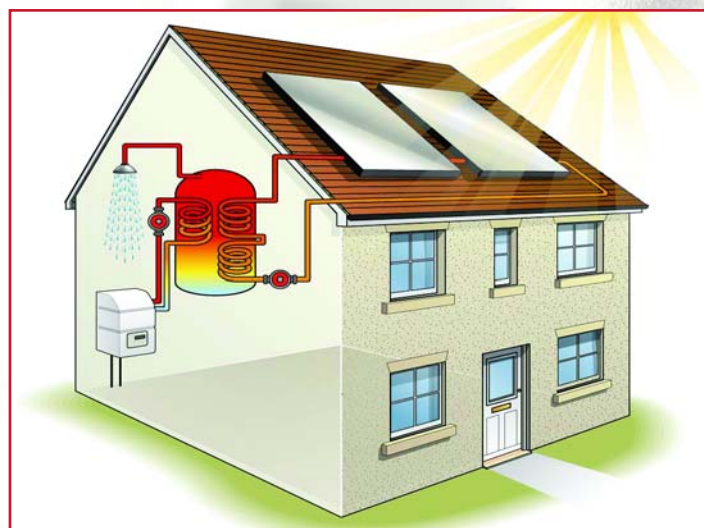

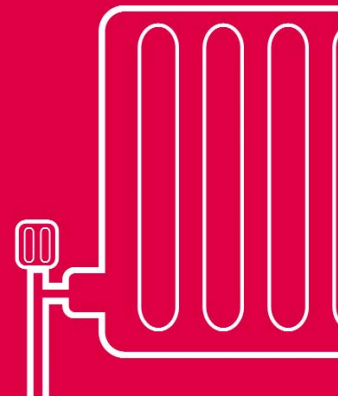
