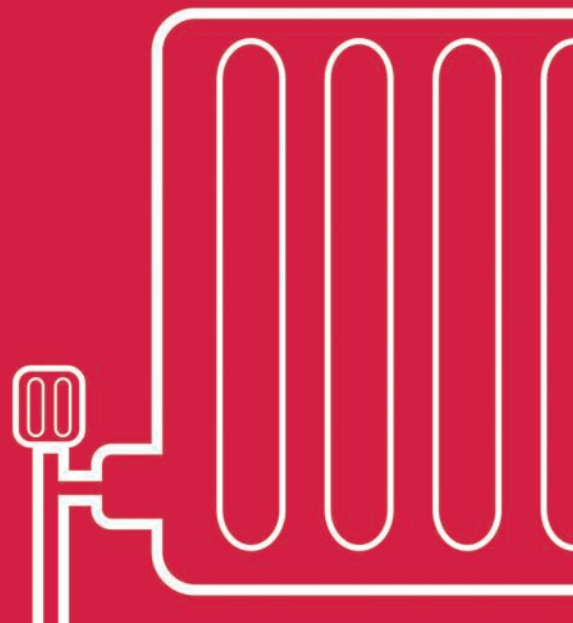

### Invitation to Conference & Exhibition

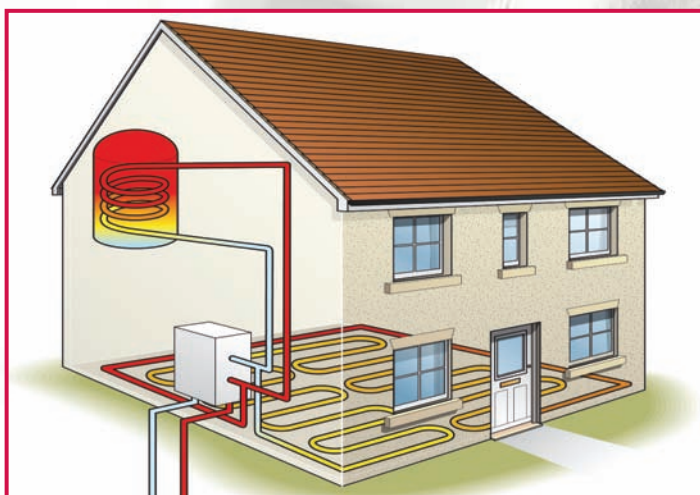
Organised by Grant Aided Heating Installers Network

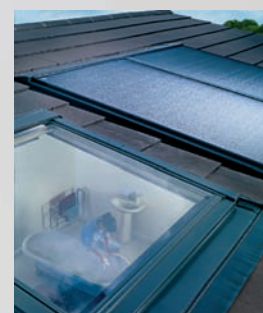

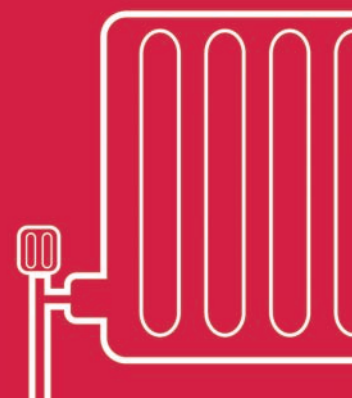
